Note:

Your patient may wish for certain pathology reports not to be submitted to My Health Record. We encourage you to discuss this with your patient. This will not affect your current business process of requesting and receiving pathology reports, it simply stops the information being sent to your patient's My Health Record.

1. In **Pathology Request**, tick **Do not send reports to My Health Record**.
