





It is suggested that you meet as a practice team to identify your QI team


Suggested team members may include:

WHAT TOPIC SHOULD I START WITH?






It is a choose your own adventure.

Option 1: Quality patient records

- The <u>Quality patient records QI toolkit</u> assists you to review your practice data
- This toolkit will help you to ensure that your patient records are maintained to the highest quality
- Activities are included to ensure your practice is meeting the e-health PIP criteria and other activities on PRODA



Option 2: Patient populations

- The <u>Patient populations toolkit</u> includes topics such as:
 - understanding your patient population
 - practice billing procedures
 - patient ethnicities and countries of birth
 - ATSI patients.
- This toolkit will help you identify the demographics of your practice so you can meet the needs of your patient community



Option 3: MBS items

- The MBS items toolkit assists you to review your practice's use of a variety of MBS item numbers.
- You will learn how to generate reports to identify the number of eligible patients vs the number of MBS item numbers claimed at your practice




Option 4: Shingles vaccine

- The <u>Shingles vaccine toolkit</u> assists you to review and identify any patients from your practice who may benefit from having a shingles vaccine
- The toolkit will guide you on how to:
 - Review practice data
 - Discuss patient lists with relevant GP
 - Increase the number of patients immunised at your practice




Completing the QI toolkits

- Practice clinical software (Best Practice, MedicalDirector etc)








