How to refer to your Domestic and Family Violence (DFV) Local Link

STEP 1. Patient discloses experience of DFV, or you have concerns for the safety of a patient due to DFV.

STEP 2. Offer support referral to DFV Local Link if it is safe to do so.

STEP 3a. Patient consents to a referral to DFV Local Link: contact us via phone, email, fax or medical objects, to complete the referral (contact details on front page).

STEP 3b. Patient does NOT consent to referral to DFV Local Link: respect their choice, offer a follow-up appointment, and call the DFV Local Link for a deidentified case consult.
