

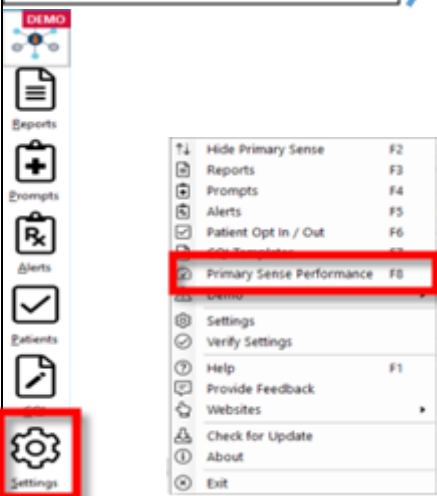
Finding the Number of Active Patients in your practice

You can easily identify the number of active patients recorded in your practice from within [Primary Sense](#).

1. Open Primary Sense.
2. Right-click the 'Settings' button.
3. Click on the 'Primary Sense Performance' option.
4. Find the 'RACGP active patients' row.

Right click 'Settings' on the Primary Sense menu and select Primary Sense Performance
