### Portfolio support and leadership

- Provide team/project coordination of relevant initiatives ensuring effective use of resources to achieve objectives within agreed timeframes and budgets.
- Oversee planning, co-design, coordination, procurement, and evaluation of services/programs (as per PHN Commissioning Framework).
- Lead community and consumer engagement approaches supporting a capacity-building approach and ensuring that community and consumer voice are central to the design approach.
- In partnership with the Program Manager, identify conditions within the system that require change and develop/execute strategies to address these – supporting progress towards systems change and better outcomes.
- Lead the development and maintenance of project management documentation and governance across the initiative.
- Work with Brisbane South PHN units and partners to develop theories of change, program logics and associated KPIs, reporting frameworks and learning systems required of the initiative.
- Support team business processes and governance across program management and service implementation functions.
- Use data to evaluate outcomes and inform continuous improvement.
- Apply knowledge of industry developments, trends, and best sector practice to identify improvement opportunities and develop innovative solutions.
- Alongside the Service Coordinators, support and coordinate commissioned services including contract
  development and management, establishing and monitoring performance, service budgets as well as
  identifying and responding to risk and issues (including critical incidents) in alignment with priorities.
- Provide evidence informed recommendations to Managers in relation to deliverables, payments, commissioning, and decommissioning decisions and to support planning more broadly.

### **Stakeholder Engagement**

- In partnership with the Program Manager, lead the development and management of stakeholder relationships (including external PHN relationships) to ensure the initiative is integrated, meets priority populations health needs and results in better outcomes for consumers.
- Identify improvements or new ways Brisbane South PHN can engage with external stakeholders to deliver new or improved health services through proactive networking.
- Represent the PHN in, or if relevant, lead operational leadership committees, advisory groups, and events as they relate to the role and organisational objectives.
- Build and maintain positive relationships with service providers to achieve optimal goals within the context of systems change.
