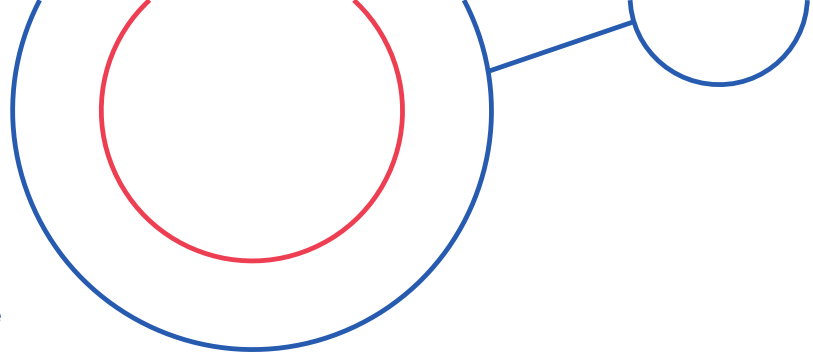

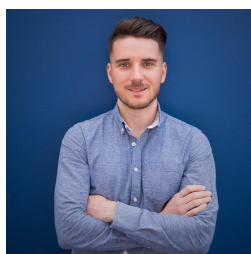
The content will focus on methods for preparing and presenting a rapid fire oral presentation.
